



NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS

Dinah L. Kilgore, RPA, Executive Director/Chief Appraiser, Interim, El Paso Central Appraisal District, is currently accepting application(s) for the following:

House Bill 3613 was passed during the **2009** legislative session and signed into law effective **September 1, 2009** for tax year **2009**. **"Under this new statute, a disabled veteran who receives from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor 100 percent disability compensation due to a service-connected disability and a rating of 100 percent disabled or of individual unemployability is entitled to an exemption from taxation of the total appraised value of the veteran's residence homestead."** The State of Texas also mandates 4 levels of exemption for disabled veteran:

10% to 29% - \$ 5,000;
30% to 49% - \$ 7,500;
50% to 69% - \$10,000;
70% and over - \$12,000 *

* Disabled veterans 65 and over with a rating of at least 10% receive the full \$12,000.

In order to update our records and afford the applicant ***the correct amount of exemption***, applications are being mailed to all property owners in El Paso County who are **currently** receiving a Veteran's disability exemption on their property. The application should be returned to our office within **thirty (30) days from the date of the letter along with the most recent disability rating letter from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.**
