## Minutes from the May 16, 2024 Meeting

The El Paso Central Appraisal District Board of Directors held its regular meeting on May 16, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of the El Paso Central Appraisal District (EPCAD), located at 5801 Trowbridge Drive, El Paso, Texas, with the following quorum of five (5) members present:

Mr. Joe Longoria of Perdue Brandon Fielder Collins and Mott LLP, EPCAD legal counsel, participated via telephone for the entire meeting.

Ms. Carmen Hegeman of Dunbar, Armendariz, Hegeman Law Firm, EPCAD legal counsel, was in attendance for the entire meeting.

The first order of business was to recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Texas state flag.

## **AGENDA ITEM 1 - STAFF RECOGNITION**

Ms. Dinah L. Kilgore, EPCAD's Executive Director/Chief Appraiser, acknowledged Gabriel Aguilar and Melissa Fernandez for their 25 years of service and James Thompson for his 30 years of service.

Chairman Berg, the Board, and all attendees extended their congratulations to them.

# AGENDA ITEM 2 - PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2024/2025 PROPOSED EPCAD BUDGET

Ms. Kilgore stated that no one had signed up to make a public comment, and no written or verbal questions had been received from the public or the entities regarding the 2024/2025 proposed EPCAD budget.

#### **AGENDA ITEM 3 - PUBLIC COMMENT**

Ms. Kilgore stated that no one had signed up to make a public comment.

Chairman Berg stated that to accommodate some time constraints of Board members, Action Agenda item six would be addressed first.

# ACTION AGENDA ITEM 6 - DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING ADOPTION OF EPCAD'S 2024/2025 BUDGET

Mr. Berg asked the board members if they had any questions, comments, or observations on the 2024/2025 budget. EPCAD staff recommended that the 2024/2025 proposed budget be \$24,805,718.09. The number of employees compensated under the proposed budget will be 157. The board members did not discuss any budget items.

Mr. Mena made a motion to approve the 2024/2025 proposed budget of \$24,805,718.09. Mr. Coronado seconded, and the vote was called and approved.

# ACTION AGENDA ITEM 4 - APPROVAL AND SIGNING OF MINUTES - APRIL 17, 2024

Mr. Haggerty motioned to approve the April 17, 2024, minutes as presented; Mr. Mena seconded, and the vote was called and approved.

## ACTION AGENDA ITEM 5 - REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORT - MARCH 2024

Ms. Rosa Goldmann, EPCAD's Chief Financial Officer, presented the financial report for March 2024. EPCAD's financial reports include the balance sheet, the report of revenues, expenditures, and changes in cash balance (actual-to-budget), the investment report, and the notes to the financial report.

As of March 2024, the Litigation Reserve encumbered funds balance is \$914,227.82, and the Board of Directors Election Reserve encumbered funds balance is \$527,886.07.

Mr. Mena motioned to approve the March 2024 financial reports as presented; Ms. York seconded, and the vote was called and approved.

# ACTION AGENDA ITEM 7 - DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING CANCELLATION OF THE JUNE 2024 AND JULY 2024 BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETING

Mr. Berg stated that historically the board does not meet in June and July due to protest hearings. Ms. Kilgore mentioned that the boardroom space is modified to accommodate panel hearings. The Appraisal Review Board (ARB) will conduct face-to-face and phone

hearings as required and allowed by the tax code. The tax code mandates that the Board of Directors meet once each quarter.

EPCAD staff requests that the board cancel the June 2024 and July 2024 Board of Directors' meetings. The next regular Board of Directors meeting will be on Thursday, August 15, 2024.

Ms. York made a motion to cancel the June 2024 and July 2024 Board of Directors meetings; Mr. Coronado seconded, and the vote was called and approved.

# ACTION AGENDA ITEM 8 - DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING ANNOUNCEMENT, APPLICANTS SOUGHT FOR APPRAISAL REVIEW BOARD MEMBERS

Ms. Kilgore stated that previously, the judge determined when to post the announcement *Applicants Sought for Appraisal Review Board Members*. However, the law has changed, and now the Board of Directors will determine when to post the announcement.

Ms. Kilgore requested that the announcement *Applicants Sought for Appraisal Review Board Members* be published in El Paso Diario, El Paso Inc., and El Paso Times on August 4, 2024.

Mr. Mena made a motion to post the announcement *Applicants Sought for Appraisal Review Board Members* on August 1, 2024; Mr. Coronado seconded, and the vote was called and approved.

# AGENDA ITEM 9 - DISCUSSION REGARDING CHANGES TO THE EPCAD BOARD OF DIRECTORS DUE TO SENATE BILL 2

Ms. Kilgore stated that changes to the EPCAD Board of Directors due to Senate Bill 2 will be on the EPCAD Board of Directors agenda on August 15, 2024, for board member to discuss or comment.

At this time no action is required.

#### **AGENDA ITEM 10 - TAXPAYER LIAISON REPORT**

Ms. Tracy Carter, Taxpayer Liaison Officer (TLO), stated that the Appraisal Review Board (ARB) started hearing protests on April 17, 2024. Additionally, she mentioned that the ARB will work five Saturdays this year, and there are currently 45 ARB members. With no questions from the board, this concluded Ms. Carter's report.

#### AGENDA ITEM 11 - CHIEF APPRAISER REPORT

Ms. Kilgore informed the board of the following:

- EPCAD was temporarily closed on April 29 30, 2024, due to a water pipe leak, resulting in extensive damage to the first and second floors. An insurance claim has been filed.
- Compared to last year EPCAD is expecting a lower number of protests.
- The deadline to protest was May 15, 2024.
- Updates to entities will be sent out at the end of May 2024 and June 2024.
- Western Refining has agreed to a value, representatives have signed off on that value associated with the company's assets in El Paso.
- EPCAD will certify the appraisal roll on July 25, 2024.
- Staff will participate in a backpack and school supplies drive for students in the Tornillo Independent School District.

With no questions from the board, Ms. Kilgore concluded her report.
