EL PASO, Texas—The El Paso Central Appraisal District announces several property tax deadline changes.

The changes are a result of House Bill 2228, which is effective for the 2018 tax year. The changes affect property owner protests, business personal property rendition statements, freeport exemption applications, and business personal property allocation applications.

The changed deadlines affected by House Bill 2228 are below:

1. Protest Deadline – The deadline to protest the appraised value of the property is May 15, or 30 days after a notice is mailed, whichever is later.
2. Business Personal Property Renditions Deadline - Rendition statements and property reports deadline is not later than April 1. (April 2 for 2018). Upon written request received **no later** than April 1, the Chief Appraiser may extend filing a rendition statement to May 1.
3. Freeport Exemption Application Deadline – Application deadline is not later than June 15.
4. Allocation Application Deadline – A taxpayer may file a completed allocation application form each year **before** April 1 (March 31 deadline).
